Important

Installing a network interface card in Deep Discovery Inspector 530/1300 requires removing the COM port permanently.

If you need the COM port to pre-configure Deep Discovery Inspector, Trend Micro recommends using Dell's iDRAC instead.

Select the appropriate network card according to the network throughput. Deep Discovery Inspector 530/1300 supports the following cards:


- Broadcom 57412 Dual Port 10Gb, SFP+, PCIe Adapter, Low Profile
- Silicom Dual Port 1GbE Copper Bypass Card for TLS Inspection
- Silicom Dual Port 10GbE Fiber-SR Bypass Card for TLS Inspection
- · Broadcom 5720 Dual Port 1Gb RJ45 Low Profile
- Silicom Dual Port 1 GbE Fiber-SX, PCIe Adapter

Install the network interface card


Procedure

- Turn off Deep Discovery Inspector.
 - a. Go to Administration > System Maintenance > Power Off / Restart.
 - b. Select Power off and click Ok.
- 2. Disconnect the power cord from the appliance.
- **3.** Install the card in the appliance.
 - a. Remove the server's top cover.
 - **b.** Remove the COM port from the appliance.
 - 1. Hold the card riser from the sides marked with blue (1), then lift the card riser.


2. Disconnect the COM port connector from the motherboard (2).




c. Open the card retention latch and remove the slot cover of an empty PCIe slot



- **d.** Align the card with the server's PCIe slot, push the card in firmly until the card connects.
- e. Close the card retention latch.



f. Secure the card holder to the server chassis.



4. Close up the server.

Check the card status

After installing, check the card status on the Deep Discovery Inspector management console.

Procedure

- **1.** After installing, check the card status on the Deep Discovery Inspector management console.
- 2. In the management console, go to **Administration > System Settings > Network Interface**.
- **3.** Check the card status.
